



Mosaic Sampler CAL - week five

Welcome to the fifth pattern of the Mosaic Sampler. We are just over half way through the patterned section of the afghan now so you should be starting to see how beautiful your colour way is looking with the different patterns.



Pattern five:

This weeks pattern reminds me of the designs you get on old greek and roman urns and I always refer to it as the zigzag pattern. It also is very similar to the pattern we completed in week three.

All seven colours are used in this pattern with the lines separating the zigzags being in one of the dark colours to give the zigzags more emphasis. There is also a row 0 as the very first row and a row 13 as the very last row in this pattern. It is a relatively quick pattern to do as six out of the twelve rows in the pattern are double crochets into the back loop, which means only six of the rows have drop trebles in them.

TIPS:

- I always tick each row off as I finish it. This way I know I won't accidentally crochet it again.
- I always check that my stitch count after the final treble matches the stitch count on the end section of the chart as this way I can see immediately if I have made any errors on the row just done.

NOTES for video:

- I use UK crochet terms throughout.
- I may refer to the double crochet into the back loop as double crochet.
- I may refer to the treble stitch into the front loop two rows below as a drop treble.
